## **UKEvents – Skills, Talent and Diversity Working Group**

- 1) Glenn Bowdin and Jenny Flinn have joined the group. A working group meeting has yet to be called for 2023, looking to arrange this towards the end of March.
- 2) Events Apprenticeship framework: Priya will be UKEvents representative on this with Richard providing top line updates. Latest update from RW:

We're behind on our timeline as working with volunteers everything is taking much longer than anticipated and we've unearthed a lot more knowledge gathering, governmental processes than we'd anticipated. However I feel now that we are picking up momentum and things are coming together;-

- Website is in final wave of construction and we aim to launch a few days prior to CONFEX as we have 3 speaker slots at the show
- Website will be focus on three groups –
- · Employers helping them understand benefits, costs, tools etc
- Apprentices explaining the world of EVENTS and the opportunities within it
- Educators / Influencers educating these groups and giving them the tools to talk to potential apprentices about the industry
- · Social media is primarily through LinkedIn and its picking up traction, building our following and interest
- · Apprenticeships we have a good working group on these that Lou Kiwanuka is leading on, we'll be launching with Events Assistant, Event Technician and Event Production Assistant (titles may change)
- · We've been in conversation with UKCCA (UK crowd control association) and they are interested in joining with us ongoing conversation
- 3) Precarious carers: Leeds Beckett Uni survey sent out to our partners which will provide insights into event careers including patterns of work, hours worked, salaries, workplace benefits (like pensions, training and development and work-life balance.

  We will be joining POE as a partner for the purpose of the research bid where we will proposing a fee/costs for our involvement in the research. They've had a few people sign up for the focus groups. Another push for survey completion is required.
- 4) SIC/SOC codes before Caroline stepped down she asked Martin Fullard if he would be interested in. I believe Caroline is still working on this as I don't have a clue.
- 5) DEI: Speaking with Alden Arnold from AEV about a cross association working group. Met with their board to discus the benefits and resources. An invitation has been extended to work alongside this group. A DEI group meeting needs to be called to discuss this. Will arrange towards the end of March.
